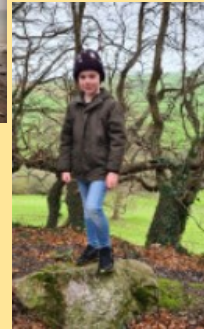
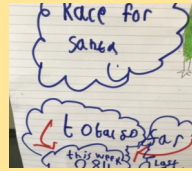

This year all of the children made a poppy which our prefects decorated our school fence with. We all took part in a 2 minute silence in order to remember our loved ones and those that we lost.



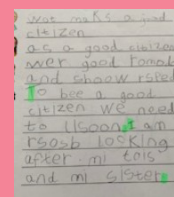
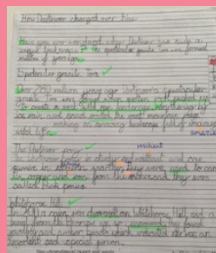
Our New Friends
